Objectives and competences

- Understand the main points of a written text on matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc.
- Understand clear speech in everyday conversation.

Composition of the B1 Test	
Listening Comprehension (less than 2 mins)	The student listens to a recorded track and then answers 6 questions (True/False).
Reading Comprehension (ca. 1700 characters)	The student reads an article followed by 6 statements that they need to mark as True / False.
Grammar Section	15 Grammar questions. Multiple choice answers, 3 options, only one is correct. For example: It's not mine, it's Select one: hers her her's
Vocabulary Section	5 Vocabulary questions. Multiple choice answers, 3 options, only one is correct. For example: He lost his job so now he is Select one: workless no work out of work
Time	The time allowed to complete the test is 35 minutes.
Navigation Method	The student can go back and forth within the test and listen to the audio track more than once.
Pass Threshold	To pass the test, a minimum of 70% of correct answers is required. No points are deducted for wrong answers. Points are neither added nor deducted for answers left blank.
